

SCENE REHEARSAL WEEK

JUNE 10-19

EXACT SCHEDULE COMING SOON

Some younger classes will be held at their usual times with no changes. Other classes will need to attend "Scene Rehearsals." During these rehearsals, students will work on their entrances, exits, and stage positions during the scenes they are on stage.

Rehearsals are MANDATORY. Please arrive on time.

You will not perform if you do not attend and are not previously excused from rehearsals.

You must remain until excused, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Please keep non-dancing siblings at home!

VOLUNTEER ROLES

Stage Assistants:

Help the Stage Manager get the students and/or props on and off the stage. If you are able to help at more than one show, the dress rehearsal, or all of them, it would be great (but not required).

Strong Assistants:

Help the Stage Manager backstage with scenery, props, etc. This is great for dads, strong moms and older siblings.

Backstage Runners:

Be the right-hand person to the Stage Managers who are on headset. Help bring dancers to the stage and other tasks.

Chaperones:

Needed for Children's and Basics Classes to help with costumes, change of shoes, getting class on and off stage, and watching them in the Green Room between dances. Chaperones are unable to leave students to watch dances from audience. You may chaperone your dancer's class or a different group.

Additional Helpers:

Needed for various tasks including Thursday Load-In, Saturday to break down the set and cleaning after the performances.

RECEIVE COSTUMES

JUNE 10 - 13

Costumes will be distributed only after all outstanding balances for the season (including tuition) are paid in full. We are planning on passing out the costumes in classes and rehearsals the week of the photo shoot. Along with your costume, you will receive written details for hair, tights, and shoe requirements. To avoid any problems, do not allow dancers to wear costumes outside of the dress rehearsals and performances.

Hair and Makeup

Required hairstyles will be sent home with the costumes and are required for the photo shoot and all dress rehearsals. Makeup is required for the stage dress rehearsal and for the performances. It is optional for the photo shoot. General makeup and hair instructions are included on page 9.

Shoes and Tights

All classes are required to have matching shoes and tights. These requirements are posted at the studio and will also be sent home with the costume instructions. If you do not own the required shoes, please talk with us about the possibility of borrowing some.



What to expect for Basics 1 & 2 Dress Rehearsal at Covey:

- 1. Check schedule to be sure of the date and time for rehearsals. See General Schedule on pg. 10
- 2. Arrive at the Covey Center. Be ready in costume, hair, and makeup by scheduled time.
- 3. Check In: You will see signs as you come into the South side parking lot of the Covey directing you to the drop off and check in area. To keep the drop off process running smoothly, please do not park or idle. If you are uncomfortable with dropping off your student, you will need to park elsewhere and walk to the Center.
- 4. We will run the Basics 1 & 2 dances in show order, including the finale. Students must stay until they are excused. Classes will get to watch each other dance. This is very fun and educational.
- 5. You will be directed where to pick up your dancer at the check in area. Please don't be late.
- 6. While waiting to be picked up, dancers must remain in the theater with WBC's faculty and chaperones. DO NOT LET CHILDREN WAIT IN HALLWAYS OR LOBBIES.

What to expect for Found 2/3, Int, Adv Dress Rehearsal at Covey:

- 1. Check schedule to be sure of the date and time for rehearsals.
- 2. Arrive at the Covey Center and enter through the lobby. Be ready in costume by scheduled time.
- 3. When rehearsal begins, we will take roll to know who is at the rehearsal.
- 4. We will run the show in order, including the finale. Then, we will rerun certain dances which need more lighting, spacing, or other help. Students must stay until they are excused.
- 5. After rehearsal, find your dancer at the CHECK IN/OUT STATION. Please don't be late. While waiting, dancers must remain with WBC's faculty until parent arrives. DO NOT LET CHILDREN WAIT IN HALLWAYS OR LOBBIES.

What to expect for ALL CLASSES:

- 1. Check schedule to be sure of the date and time for performances
- 2. Arrive at the Covey Center (directions on page 5) ready with hair, make up, and costumes at scheduled time
- 3. Enter in the performer's entrance then check in at the CHECK-IN STATION. This person will guide you to where your child should go.
- 4. After the performance, pick up your dancer and check out at the same check-in location near the performers' entrance.
 - Dancers are not allowed to watch the performance or go into the lobby
 - All performers are involved in the finale
 - · Theater seating begins 30 min prior to show time
 - Video and photography are not allowed at the performance

Dear Performer and Family,

Welcome to the Covey Center for the Arts! We're excited to have you with us! To help you have the best experience on the day of your performance please be aware of the following:

- Only performers and approved personnel will be permitted in the backstage area, and they will not be able to enter the lobbies once they are checked in. There are restrooms in the dressing rooms and a drinking fountain backstage for your convenience.
- There is a new traffic pattern to get to the loading bay and usual performers' entrance located on the southwest corner of the building. Please follow all posted signs.
- Please arrive at your assigned time and have only one person accompany your performer to the check-in area to avoid crowding. Performers must be picked up at the same location after the performance.
- Performers are asked to limit the items they bring backstage. Please leave unneeded items at home to avoid crowding.
- We encourage all costume changes to be done in the green rooms or changing tents. There are security cameras in the hallways and backstage areas, including the dance studios.
- We do not allow food or beverages (besides water) in the theater or in the lobbies. Those with food
 in these areas will be asked to leave. Participants may bring food backstage only if their director
 allows it.
- The lobbies will be closed outside of regular business hours. At those times, no one will be permitted in the lobbies, including parents/families of performers.
- Please use the dressing rooms backstage for hair, makeup and costume changes or come with hair and makeup already done. Lobbies, restrooms, and the theater are not to be used for these activities.
- Parents/Friends/Audience members are not permitted onstage or backstage. Please arrange to pick up your participant in the loading bay after the performance.
- With the demolition of the old City Center, parking at the Covey has changed from last year. Parking is located south and east of the Covey Center. If that lot fills, there is additional parking near 100 S and 200 W. Please plan on some extra time to find a parking spot and enjoy a walk! A parking map is included at the end of this letter.

Other things to keep in mind:

- Tickets may be purchased online, in person, or over the phone. Please call the Box Office to claim any complimentary tickets approved by your organization. Ticket availability is not guaranteed.
- There is a \$3 per ticket fee to exchange tickets, including complimentary tickets. No tickets will be exchanged the day of the performance
- Lobbies will open one hour prior the event on Saturdays.
- The theater will open 30 minutes prior to the performance.

The Perfect Bur

1. PUT HAIR IN A PONYTAIL AT THE CROWN OF THE HEAD (OR DESIRED LOCATION).

For performances, start with wet hair and slick with a LOT of gel or hairspray. Make sure the ponytail is tight, that way your hair pins will also be tight. Brush and smooth hair toward the ponytail. Do a light spray of hair spray before starting the bun.

TIP: For thick hair, wrap two hair ties at once for a better hold.

2. TWIST HAIR AND BEGIN WRAPPING AROUND ELASTIC IN A SPIRAL, PINNING IN PLACE AS YOU GO.

Pin the hair as you wrap it around the bun – do not wrap all the hair before pinning. Continue to twist and pin until hair is wound in the shape of a cinnamon roll. The bun should be as FLAT against the head as possible.

TIPS:

Push the hairpins out from the center of the bun, grab some hair then push back under the bun toward the center of the bun. When you push the hairpin straight into the hair, it opens up the hairpin and it pops right back out.

Pinning as you go keeps each round flat to the head. When you get to a second row or spiral of the bun, do not push the new layer under the first, keep it outside (to prevent the doorknob bun). Tuck the ends into the bun and pin under the bun.

3 WRAP HAIRNET AROUND HAIR & SECURE ALL "WISPIES"

Open up the hairnet and put it around the bun. Pull the net to one side, twist, and wrap 1 or 2 more times over the bun. Take the remainder of the net and pin it with the rest of your hair. Pin the net along the edges of the bun, securing it to your head.

Add hairspray around the head and bun – Particularly around the ears, base of neck, and top of head.

TIP: Experiment with different shapes and sizes of hair pins to find what works best for your hair type.



Stage Makeup



Makeup MUST be worn on stage to avoid looking washed out. Apply makeup similar to average everyday wear, only darker. For younger dancers, eyeliner is optional.

FOUNDATION: Matte powder matching skin tone to prevent skin from becoming too shiny under stage lights.

EYES: Brown or black eyeliner, brown eyeshadows. Black mascara. Intermediate and Advanced dancers are required to wear false eyelashes. Other dancers can if they'd like.

BLUSH: Red or Pink Blush. DO NOT use browns. They look black on stage.

LIPS: RED lipstick. NO browns.
